Dear Minister Yoon:

I have the honor to refer to the United States-Korea Free Trade Agreement (hereinafter referred to as the "Agreement") signed in Washington, D.C. on June 30, 2007.

I have the further honor to propose by this letter to confirm on behalf of the Government of the United States of America the understanding reached by the United States of America and the Republic of Korea to amend and replace in their entirety Annex 4-A (Specific Rules of Origin for Textile or Apparel Goods), Annex 6-A (Specific Rules of Origin), and Appendix 6-A-1 (Correlation Table for Footwear) of the Agreement, as set forth in the Appendices to this letter. These amendments are technical adjustments that do not constitute substantive changes to the Agreement, and have the sole purpose of maintaining consistency between the Agreement, its Annexes and Appendices and each Party's tariff laws and regulations.

Therefore, I have the honor to propose that this letter and its Appendices, and your letter of confirmation in reply and its Appendices, shall constitute an agreement between our two Governments on the amendments to the Agreement. I have the further honor to propose that this agreement and the amendments to the Agreement shall enter into force on such date as our two Governments agree, after they have exchanged written notifications certifying that they have completed their respective applicable legal requirements and procedures.
