

Promoting Supply Chain Resilience

Virtual Public Hearing

On May 23, 2024, the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative convened a virtual public hearing on Promoting Supply Chain Resilience.

Along with the Departments of Commerce and Labor, and U.S. Customs and Border Protection, USTR received testimony from and posed questions to representatives of think tanks; environmental NGOs; and companies and trade associations covering a range of sectors, including clean energy, forging and molding, technology, and retail. The testimony included discussion of the U.S. Foreign Trade Zone program, environmental and labor protections, enforcement of U.S. trade laws, ways to enhance small business participation in supply chains, and other U.S. trade and investment policies.
